We are proud to share that we are on target to treat over **1,400 patients** by the end of this year. With our incredible team of medical volunteers, we have been able to provide comprehensive medical services to hard-working individuals who do not receive health insurance through their employer. Because of our generous donors, the Clinic is able to sustain the services currently provided to hard-working individuals. **These services are essential to help them continue to be productive members of society.**

For example, a 47 year old woman visited the Clinic with a blood sugar of 300. With the direction of the medical team, her medication and lifestyle changes have lowered her blood sugar to a now healthy level. She is now able to continue being the primary caregiver for her family, which includes a young son, without risk of hospitalization from complications of diabetes.

We were thrilled to celebrate that Christ's Family Clinic has been treating thousands of adults just like the patient above for **20 years**.
