We recently saw a patient whose father was diagnosed with a hereditary condition called hemochromatosis. After testing, we confirmed that the patient also has this disorder, which leads to excessive iron buildup in the body. To manage this he will receive regular blood draws to remove the excess iron. This treatment will prevent him from developing severe liver disease and liver failure.

A 60-year-old woman, discovered her blood sugar was over 200 during a visit to urgent care for an upper respiratory infection. Without insurance, she had not seen a doctor in many years and was unaware of her diabetes. We initiated treatment for her diabetes, high blood pressure, and high cholesterol. She expressed gratitude for finding the clinic, as she hadn't thought affordable healthcare was available to her. Management of these conditions will prevent her from developing heart disease and many other complications that would severely affect the quality of her life.
